3. Strengthening the enabling environment

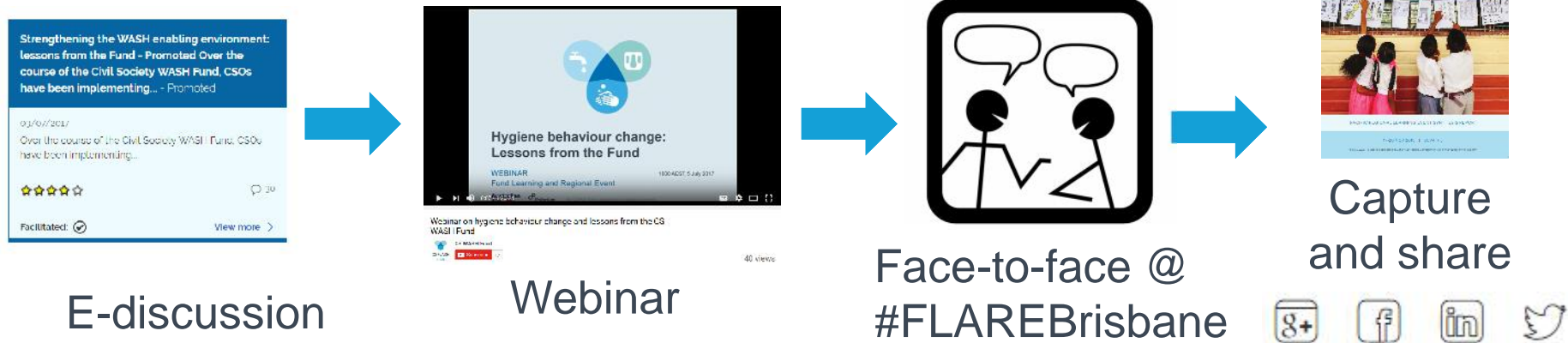
