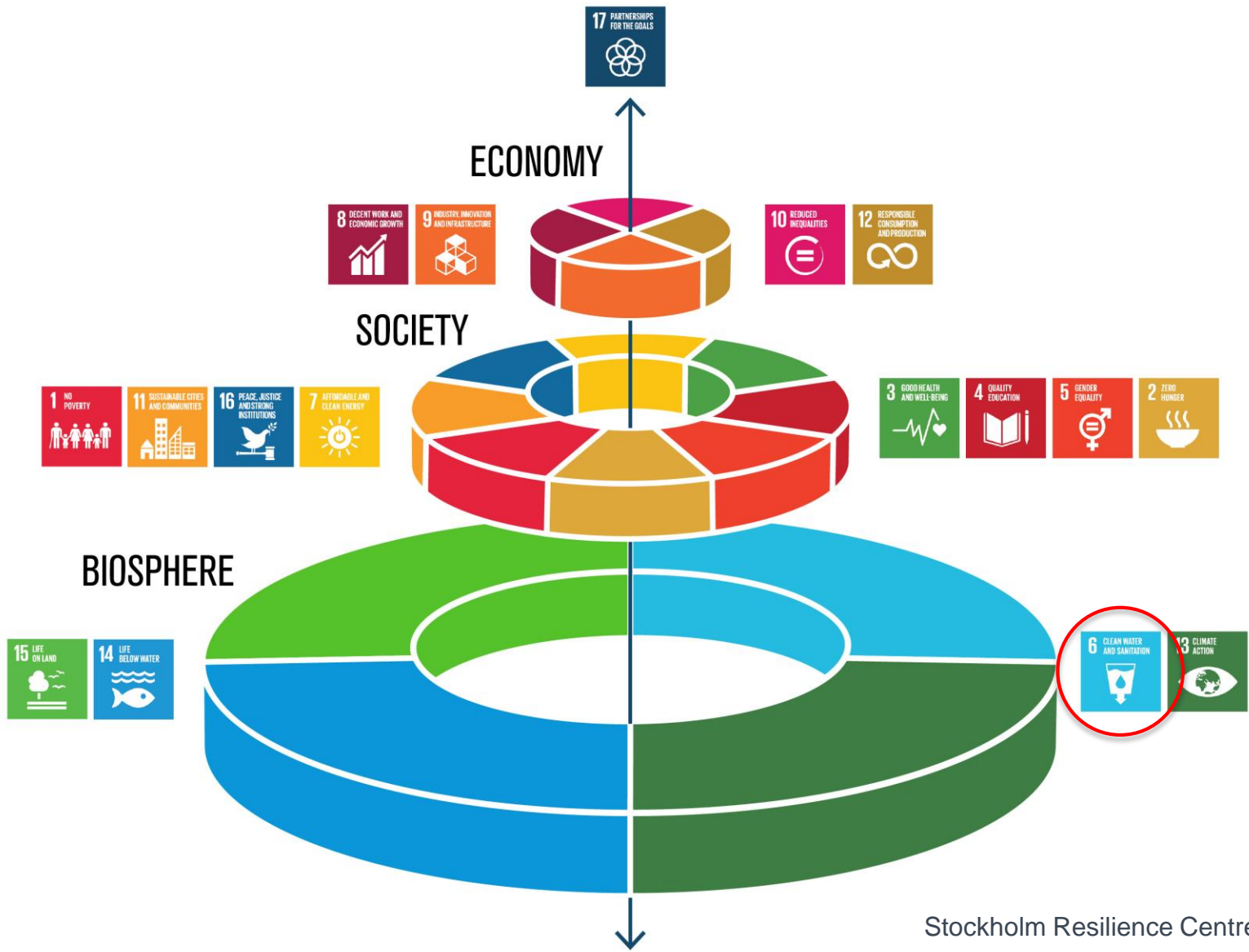

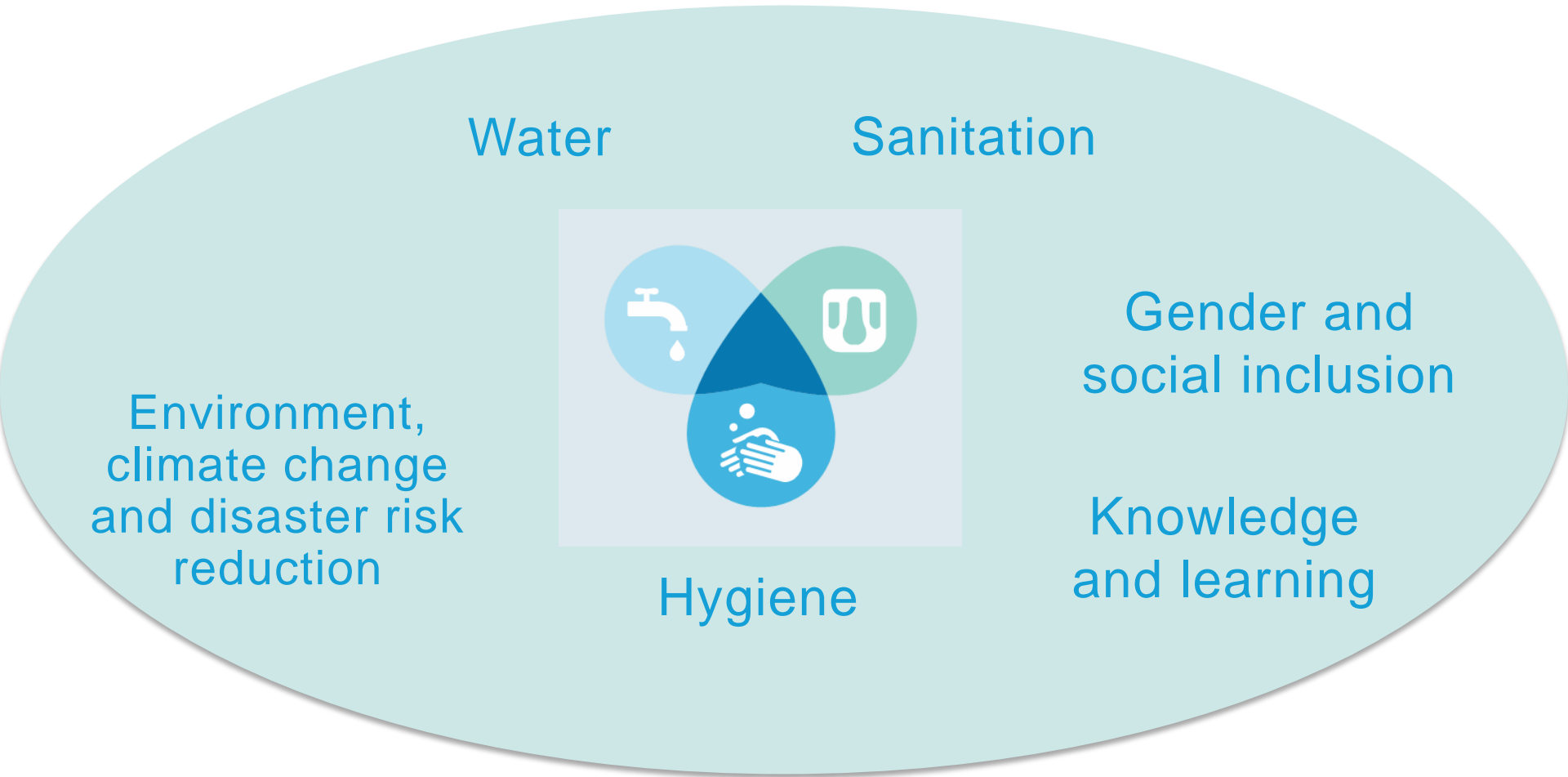

## Civil Society WASH Fund project locations

8 projects led by 6 CSOs

- Handwashing facility construction – 8 (all)
- Latrine construction – 7 projects
- Waste management – 7 projects
- Water quality management – 5 projects
- Financing approaches (grants, loans, etc) - All

1. Improve the understanding of CSO approaches to strengthening change agent systems at multiple levels for demand and supply-side sanitation;
2. Explore approaches to ensuring total sanitation for all; and
3. Improve understanding of effective integrated hygiene behaviour change activities to ensure maximum health benefits.

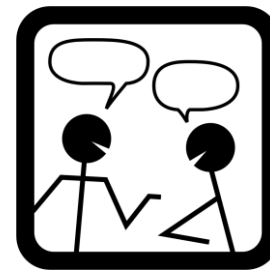

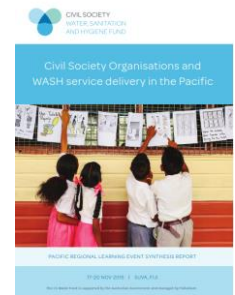
