### Impact of Healthy Islands Approach

- Triggering sustained hygiene behaviour change (Targeting mindset at an Individual, family, tribe and community level)
- Strengthens existing community leadership
- Increases community engagement, participation and ownership

- Rapid reduction of social issues and hence influence WaSH indicators
- Networking and partnerships with different levels of government and other stakeholders
- Impact on "Non-Project" communities
- Illustrates potential for scale-up








