

LOW-COST TECHNOLOGY ADAPTATIONS

- Optimize use of materials & reduce labor costs (concrete rings)
- 2. Use of cheaper materials (concrete blocks)
- 3. Adjust dimensions



BUNDLING OPTIONS

- 1. Lower transportation costs
- 2. Lower transaction cost
- 3. Latrine financing




- 1. Latrine options information through Sales agents











RESULT - Intervention in 9 communes

LESSON LEARNT

- Geography not ethnicity influences drivers
- The SANCON model has demonstrated potential, but requires modification, particularly in areas with dispersed villages and weak supply chains.
- The government system can implement BCC activities but external support is still required to spur sanitation supply chains
- Connection BCC and SC is very important



LESSON LEARNT


SANCON:

- drain concrete ring/brick producer or construction material retailer
- Pay by installment
- Price options
- The number of SANCON depends on distance and demand
- Support provided in business planning and package costing
- Sale agent:
 - can be health motivator
 - Number of SA: can be until one per village
 - Need to clarify clearly the benefit from SANCON
