Project objectives (Theory of change)

Change agents

 Effective government knowledge, skills and commitment at district and commune level to achieve sustainable WASH improvements for communities.

Impacts

- Improved WASH behaviours at the household level, with a focus on hand washing with soap, using toilets and drinking safe water.
- Increased access to sanitation infrastructure for households and schools












3. Increased use of equitable sanitation services







4. Central Women Union with support from Plan VNM:

Pilot the application of Gender WASH Monitoring Tool and Low Cost Sanitation Options in 6 selected provinces Results:

- □ 23 WU staff and 5 masons of the Central and 6 provinces attended training on GWMT, Low Cost Sanitation Options and approaches to involve local community participation to reduce the cost.
- □ PRA sessions on GWMT conducted with participation from 10 villages
- □ 20 sample low cost toilets were made under WU supervision for show to the community people
- WU links to support 75 HH to borrow 600 Mil VNM from provincial water revolving fund for making HH toilets (in Nghe An), with 0.6% interest rate







5. Thinking to improve Sanitation M&E system to serve monitoring the Country ODF Achievement by 2025

Plan VNM introduced to VIHEMA, UNICEF and NGOs at the National Sanitation Working Group Meeting:

- □ The WEB based WASH program indicators monitoring system (PIMS) that had been developed and used since 2011, with Vietnam GIS MAP merged
- Mobile Application, using mobile phone for field data collection that have been developed and piloted in 2015
