


### PLAN INTERNATIONAL INDONESIA'S WORKING AREAS OF STBM PROGRAM



Population: 158 HH/784 people

Livelihood: Farmers (Casava, coffee, cocoa, rice, coconut), Teachers,

Village Government Officers



#### Who do you liaise with to arrange a visit?



Village Head is the first person who meet us in the village. He will liaise us to meet community



#### Who do you meet on a site visit?







**During visit to village we meet**: Village STBM Team, Sanitation and Hygiene Officer, Village Head, Health Volunter, Woman Group, Children and PWD

When walking around the village we talk to villagers to understand their perspectives



#### What do you do on a site visit?



- Collect monitoring data
- Monitoring STBM Facility
- Undertake STBM training for Village Health Volunteer
- Hygiene Promotion for community
- CLTS triggering
- Discuss women and men's perspectives with relation to WASH



### Any particular challenges facing the project in this location?



- The project location is very remote
- 2. They have very limited water spring
- 3. The only water source they can count on is rain
- 4. However every July-October rain also rare
- 5. Tiwerea people so far have to buy water Rp450.000/tank (\$45)



## Particular successes you would highlight to visitors?





- 1. They are committed to practice good STBM behaviours
- 2. Limitation of water does not excuse people to stop OD
- 3. Good local innovations in making sanitation and hygiene facilities
- 4. Village Head lead community effectively on behavior change
- 5. Tiwerea villages have also implement solutions for PWD by "gotong royong"
